

## NEWHAM BRIDGE INFORMATION 2017

In 2016, the new more challenging national curriculum, which was introduced in 2014 was assessed by new tests and interim frameworks for teacher assessment. Results are no longer reported as levels.

Over half of pupils (National) reached the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics.  
63% of pupils reached the new expected standard.

**At Newham Bridge Primary 69% of pupils reached the new expected standard.**

Newham Bridge currently has 69% pupils meeting the expected standard. The school has a progress score 2.3 in English Reading .A progress score of -0.4 in English writing and in Mathematics Newham Bridge currently has a progress score of 2.4

Newham Bridge Primary **IS ABOVE FLOOR** as the school has more than 65% pupils who met the expected standard and the school has sufficient progress scores in all three subjects.
