Our Year 6 pupils had a super visit to Eden Camp on Tuesday this week, to support their 'Fallen Fields' topic. We also had groups of Year 5 and 6 pupils attending the Middlesbrough Schools Tag Rugby Tournament earlier this week. The children tried hard and showed great sportsmanship when competing against other schools. Today our Year 3 children are venturing out into the local area for their Pedestrian training – learning how to keep themselves safe in the community. Unfortunately, whilst we expect to have colds and flu bugs about at this time of year, we have also had a number of positive Covid cases reported this week amongst pupils, parents and staff. Please be vigilant for Covid symptoms, a high temperature, headache, sickness and a persistent cough. We do endeavour to minimise the risks in school and within the wider community.

**SWIMMING: YEAR 6 (19 pupils only)**

Our Year 6 (19 children) will start their swimming on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October. The children will attend a daily lesson for the next 2 weeks, Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October, at the 'Rainbow' pool. The children need their costume, towel and goggles (if required). All children are encouraged to develop skills to complete their 25m swim with confidence.

**Children who have already achieved their 25metre swim are not required to attend these swimming sessions.**
