MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones are not permitted in school however, we do permit our Year 6 children, who have provided written consent to walk home alone, requiring a phone for their safety - to bring them in. Year 6 phones are collected daily, kept securely during school hours and are returned as pupil's leave the premises. Mobile phones, particularly photos are not to be taken on the school site.

ATTENDANCE

Excellent attendance and punctuality is a key factor to success. Unfortunately, the borough's school absence rate is higher than the National average. Middlesbrough is the first area to take part in a pilot scheme with the Department for Education to combat low school attendance rates. Attendance in school should remain, ideally above 96% allowing for minimal sickness absence.

After half term, if pupil absence is a concern, you will receive a letter from school. Meetings with our Social Inclusion Lead Mr Grierson and our Education Welfare Officer will take place to discuss pupil attendance and offer families guidance and support.

<u>PE DAYS</u>: PE sessions will be changing after half term and we ask that the Year 1 – Year 6 children **come to school in their kit** (white t-shirt, black shorts, joggers and a sweatshirt, plimsolls or trainers). The children's new PE days are as follows:
