#### **2023 IMPORTANT DATES**

Year 2 statutory assessments begin Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May and finish 19th May 2023 (completed in smaller groups) Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is the week beginning 12<sup>th</sup> June, finishing on the 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023

Year 4 mandatory Multiplication Tables Check take place between Monday 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

During this period we also complete our assessments for the rest of the school.
