2024 IMPORTANT DATES

We would like to make you aware that our Year 6, Year 2, Year 1 and Year 4 statutory assessments will be taking place during May and June 2024 this year.

Year 6 statutory assessments begin Monday 13th May and finish Friday 17th May 2024.

Year 2 (optional) statutory assessments begin Monday 20th May and finish 24th May 2024 (completed in smaller groups)
Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is the week beginning 10th June, finishing on the 14th June 2024

Year 4 mandatory Multiplication Tables Check take place between Monday 3rd – Friday 14th June 2024.

During this period we also complete our assessments for the rest of the school.
