2024 IMPORTANT DATES

Year 2 (optional) statutory assessments begin Monday 20th May and finish 24th May 2024 (completed in smaller groups) Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is the week beginning 10th June, finishing on the 14th June 2024

Year 4 mandatory Multiplication Tables Check take place between Monday 3rd – Friday 14th June 2024.

During this period we also complete our assessments for the rest of the school.

- * Children should receive bigger portions for lunch
- * Nursery staff offer lots of support and are doing a great job getting my child ready for Reception.
- * I'd like to say thank you to all the teaching staff. You're all brilliant!
- * My child has just started in Nursery and she is happy and comfortable. Thank you!
- * There are times when younger persons language (swears) is an issue. Presence in the playground is well received.
- * Staff seem unenthusiastic working with small children, with minimal interaction with parents about the day.
- * Staff and HT are approachable
- * Questionnaire not purely based on present experience......staff changes are required in my opinion
- * Lovely to see a staff member in the playground on a morning greeting pupils.
- * I would appreciate if the school teachers would take extra time to listen to the children when they complain/ report to them. Thank you.
- * My child has recently had some anxiety about school, but I think it is due to challenge of learning subjects as they increase in difficulty.

- * Needs to be a staff member on Cayton Drive.
- * Please could there be suggestions to Parents not to smoke at drop off and pick up times on Cayton Drive.
- * Love the new parking buddies, however it hasn't stopped parents dropping off further down the road which is inconsiderate It is the same parents daily

COMMUNICATION:

- * Qu 3: Could be clearer in letters eg Nativity
- * Sometimes difficult to find homework and spelling on the website. Would be brilliant if two parents could access the gateway app. We have spoken to the Reception team and it has not been possible.
- * The report format half way through the year is clear and school could provide links to learning sites to help.
- * Only been in school for a few months, still struggling to find appropriate info on website for spelling and homework.
- * Contacted school via email didn't get acknowledged.
- * Communication would be better if it could be accessed by both parents.
- * Emailing newsletters would be preferable than the paper newsletter. They could be sent to multiple parents.
- * The classes section for Y2 is not updated. Last update was Christmas!
- * A rewards app to see rewards given throughout the day would be beneficial
- * Booking appointments on the school app is difficult and I'm not able to do so, making it harder for my involvement.
- * Accident slips often found in book bag not passed to person picking up
- * Would be lovely to see children having fun with activities (photos)
- * More communication: Drop off and settling in

EXTRA CURRICULAR PROVISION:

- * Different physical activities to cover children's interests
- * Breakfast Club Provision and more dress-up days
- * It would be great for more ASClubs which run until 5-6pm, supporting working parents.
- * My child has not been in the school long enough. The only reason I would not recommend the school it has no
- Breakfast/ASClub. Other than this the school is great and my child loves it here.
- * My daughter enjoys school and after school clubs
- * More for children out of school: discos, fayres. Open climbing frame.
- * Lack of breakfast and after school clubs. School doesn't take part in World Book Day and football events like other schools.

SCHOOL DINNERS
