

PARKING / DROP OFF

We would like to remind you about our 'drop off zone' on Cawood Drive. The Cawood Drive gate opens at 8.40am and is supervised by Staff. Pupils from Year 2 – Year 6 and families, where an older child can support siblings into school, can enter school from here. Have a try......Drop and drive from Cawood Drive!

NURSERY PLACES: September 2024

If you have a child eligible to start Nursery next year, (turning 3 before end of March 2025) and have not completed an application for a place, forms are available from the school office. We do require sight of birth certificate and proof of address.
