HEALTH SURVEY

Your local authority public health team, Public Health South Tees, would like to gather the views of parents/carers regarding the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) which takes place yearly in schools. The NCMP is a statutory requirement of all local authorities, supported by the Health and Social Care Act 2012. Each year, height and weight data are collected by trained healthcare providers for children in Reception and Year 6. These height and weight measurements are used to help the local authority and NHS to plan the provision of services to support healthy lifestyles for children and families in the local area.

Feedback letters are sent to parents/carers detailing their child’s result. Within these letters, we currently use a range of terms used by the NHS. Feedback suggests that the existing letter, based on the national letter template, could be improved in order to be more neutral in tone, empathetic and supportive as well as to better support families.
