DOGS: DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON OUR SCHOOL PREMISES/SITE

We have received complaints regarding dogs situated near the main entrance gates, which are making some children anxious about coming in and out of school. We request that all dogs maintain a significant distance (5-10 metres) from the entrance gates, at the start and end of the day, to support those individuals who may be anxious / fearful. **We appreciate your support.**

PARKING: Please **DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL GATES.** It is our ONLY ACCESS for emergency vehicles and deliveries.

UNIFORM/ WEATHER

During the Summer months we request that children bring sun hats/caps to school and in the event of a good forecast and high temperatures – please could sunscreen be applied before your child comes to school. Our school uniform is...

Black shoes should be worn with school uniform. Alternatively **black** trainers may be worn.
Hair styles should not be extreme and are considered part of the uniform. No tram lines nor hair dyes.

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS AND VISITS: SUMMER TERM

During this term, we have a number of trips and visits taking place across school. Whilst school subsidises all visits from the school budget, we do request a voluntary contribution from families **to be paid via the school gateway app.** Voluntary contributions will be used to support the costs of: transport, hire of facilities, entrance fees, tickets, engaging an activity provider (e.g. theatre trip, sports coach, drama group) board and lodging on residential trips, purchasing materials - equipment for an activity and insurance. Unfortunately, where **sufficient funds are not generated to support the activity it may not be possible for it to go ahead.**
