SCHOOL INFORMATION

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS AND VISITS: SUMMER TERM

During this term, we have a number of trips and visits taking place across school. Whilst school subsidises all visits from the school budget, we do request a voluntary contribution from families **to be paid via the school gateway app**. Voluntary contributions will be used to support the costs of: transport, hire of facilities, entrance fees, tickets, engaging an activity provider (e.g. theatre trip, sports coach, drama group) board and lodging on residential trips, purchasing materials - equipment for an activity and insurance. Unfortunately, where **sufficient funds are not generated to support the activity it may not be possible for it to go ahead**.

School attendance is mandatory for all pupils. Parents should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission to take their children out of school.

HOUSEHOLD SUPPORT FUND – Financial Support for Families with children
