SCHOOL INFORMATION

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS AND VISITS: SUMMER TERM

During this term, we have a number of trips and visits taking place across school. Whilst school subsidises all visits from the school budget, we do request a voluntary contribution from families **to be paid via the school gateway app.** Voluntary contributions will be used to support the costs of: transport, hire of facilities, entrance fees, tickets, engaging an activity provider (e.g. theatre trip, sports coach, drama group) board and lodging on residential trips, purchasing materials - equipment for an activity and insurance. Unfortunately, where **sufficient funds are not generated to support the activity it may not be possible for it to go ahead.**

TERM TIME HOLIDAYS

School attendance is mandatory for all pupils. Parents should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission to take their children out of school.

School holidays during term time will not be authorised.

HOUSEHOLD SUPPORT FUND – Financial Support for Families with children

Middlesbrough Council has been provided with funding to provide financial assistance towards energy costs, water bills and food as well as other essential costs to those in need.
