UNIFORM SEPTEMBER 2024

From September 2024 all pupils will be expected to wear school uniform –

Red jumper/cardigan, grey or black trousers/skirt, white polo/white shirt, black shoes

From September 2024 pupils will be expected to wear school PE uniform –

Indoor PE: **white t-shirt, black shorts, plimsolls/trainers, plain joggers (no branding), school jumper** for outdoors.

Uniform also incorporates the wearing of **small ear studs** only. Please remove for PE.

If you have an issue with your child’s uniform – please make staff aware. However, if staff identify an issue with your child’s uniform, you may receive a call from school.
