It has been lovely to welcome our Nursery children back this week into our lovely, newly refurbished Nursery. The children have settled in well. We would also like to extend a warm Newham Bridge welcome to the many new families who have recently joined us at Newham Bridge. We hope you enjoy being a part of our school community.

MEDICAL: ALLERGIES.....PLEASE MAKE SCHOOL AWARE IF YOUR CHILD DEVELOPS AN ALLERGY

We have a number of children across school with specific allergies. Allergies can be life-threatening and as a result Newham Bridge Primary School is a <u>NUT FREE / NO NUT</u> school. In school, we do everything we can to mitigate risk. However, school cannot be held responsible for food brought from home eg: Packed Lunches for lunch, Educational Visits, Sporting Events and UKS2 Homework Club Snacks. Please consider carefully the contents of any packed lunch/food that you are providing for your child in school eg No Nutella, Choc/Hazelnut Spread, Kinder Bueno, Snickers etc. We appreciate your support. Thank you! The LA Catering team and School kitchen staff are currently introducing new food preparation areas to minimise pupil risk from the 14 allergens (Food Standards Agency).

PACKED LUNCHES If your child is bringing a packed lunch. Please ensure there are **NO NUTS**, as **we are a <u>NUT-FREE</u> school**, no sweets/chocolate bars and please provide a still drink, no fizzy drinks. Thank you!

DINNER MONEY: For those families Y3 – Y6 who have paid school meals. The costs are £2.40 per day/ £12 per week **to be paid weekly on Mondays** via the School gateway app. If you wish to change your child's meal type eg to a packed lunch - school requires at least a weeks notice. Thank you!

Maths - Key Instant Recall Facts (Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2: Y1-6)

This week your child will be arriving home with a letter all about Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRF) in Maths. KIRFs are facts your child needs to be able to recall with speed and accuracy. Each letter will explain the objective your child is working on for the half term; it will give you an example of a task your child will do in school, vocabulary and home learning ideas. We suggest working with your child little and often at home to help them recall these facts to support mental maths work in school.
