Dear Parents and Carers,


This week in school we have been thinking about 'Kindness.' How small acts

ATTENDANCE

As you know, good attendance (above 96%) is crucial to make sure your child receives the best from their time at Newham Bridge.

You may have heard about our new rewards in assembly or your child may have been lucky enough to be awarded our weekly attendance champion. If you have any questions or would like support with attendance, please come in and speak to staff.

TERM TIME HOLIDAYS

School attendance is mandatory for all pupils. Parents should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission to take their children out of school.

School holidays during term time will not be authorised. Fixed Penalty Notices are being issued by the LA.

<u>WATER BOTTLES</u>: We requested that all children bring their own bottle to school this year. These should be plastic, **no metal bottles or air up bottles.** For those who don't have bottles, cups will be provided so they can still access a drink in school.

YEAR 4 SWIMMING (Group 1)

Our Year 4 (Group 1) will start their swimming on Monday 7th October. Swimming is the only sport named in our school statutory PE curriculum. The children will attend a daily lesson for the next 2 weeks, Monday 7th October – Friday 18th October, at the 'Rainbow' pool. The children need their costume, towel and goggles (if required). All children are encouraged to develop their water safety skills, work towards completing their 25m swim with confidence and have fun!
