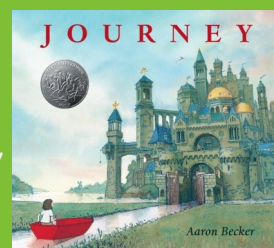
Staff Recommendation
