2025 IMPORTANT DATES

We would like to make you aware that our Year 6, Year 1 and Year 4 statutory assessments will be taking place during May and June 2025 this year.

Year 6 statutory assessments begin Monday 12th May and finish Friday 16th May 2025.

Year 4 mandatory Multiplication Tables Check take place between Monday 2nd June and Friday 13th June 2025.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is the week beginning 9th June, finishing on the 13th June 2025

During this period we also complete our assessments for the rest of the school.
