EDUCATIONAL TRIPS AND VISITS: SUMMER TERM

During this term, there are many trips and visits taking place across school. Whilst school subsidises all visits from the school budget, we do request a voluntary contribution from families **to be paid via the school gateway app**. Voluntary contributions will be used to support the costs of: transport, hire of facilities, entrance fees, tickets, engaging an activity provider (e.g. theatre trip, sports coach, drama group) board and lodging on residential trips, purchasing materials - equipment for an activity and insurance. Unfortunately, where **sufficient funds are not generated to support the activity it may not be possible for it to go ahead**.

ATTENDANCE: LATES/ABSENCE

Just to remind you that our school doors open at 8.40am and close at 9.00am for registration. Any arrival after 9.00am must go through the school office and will be recorded as a late on your child's attendance record. We appreciate your support – Thank you! The Cawood Drive 'Drop off area' is supervised by staff and also opens from 8.40am for Y2-Y6 pupils.
