**YEAR 4 SWIMMING (Group 1)** Our Year 4 (Group 1) will start their swimming on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October. Swimming is the only sport named in our school statutory PE curriculum. The children will attend a daily lesson for the next 2 weeks, Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October, at the 'Rainbow' pool. The children need their costume, towel and goggles (if required). All children are encouraged to develop their water safety skills, work towards completing their 25m swim with confidence and have fun!
