We have had a lovely week in school. Our children are now settled in the routines and this week we completed our fire practice – thankfully in the better weather. The children were great, staying calm and listening carefully

YEAR 4 SWIMMING (Group 1) Our Year 4 (2JH) and some Year 5 will start their swimming on Monday 6th October. Swimming is the only sport named in our school statutory PE curriculum. The children will attend a daily lesson for the next 2 weeks, Monday 6th October - Friday 17th October, at the 'Rainbow' pool. The children need their costume, towel and goggles (if required). All children are encouraged to develop their water safety skills, work towards completing their 25m swim with confidence and have fun!

REMINDER: Please could Parents respect that our school premises are a place for children. Hence smoking, vaping and dogs are prohibited. Please dismount cycles and scooters. Inappropriate language and swearing will not be tolerated. We all have a responsibility to safeguard our children.

PACKED LUNCHES: If your child is bringing a packed lunch. Please ensure there are NO NUTS, as we are a NUT-FREE school, no sweets/chocolate bars and please provide a still drink, no fizzy drinks. Thank you!
