 This week our Year 4/5 pupils started their swimming at the Rainbow pool. They have enjoyed their first week and have tried their best. Well done! Swimming continues next week. See below.....

YEAR 4 SWIMMING (Group 1) Our Year 4 (2JH) and some Year 5 will continue their swimming on Monday 13th October. Swimming is the only sport named in our school statutory PE curriculum. The children will attend a daily lesson for another week, Monday 13th October – Friday 17th October, at the 'Rainbow' pool. The children need their costume, towel and goggles (if required). All children are encouraged to develop their water safety skills, work towards completing their 25m swim with confidence and have fun!

REMINDER: Please could Parents respect that our school premises are a place for children. Hence smoking, vaping and dogs are prohibited. Please dismount cycles and scooters. Inappropriate language and swearing will not be tolerated. We all have a responsibility to safeguard our children.
