ATTENDANCE: LATES/ABSENCE

Just to remind you that our school doors open at 8.40am and close at 9.00am for registration. Any arrival after 9.00am must go through the school office and will be recorded as a late on your child's attendance record. We appreciate your support – Thank you! The Cawood Drive 'Drop off area' is supervised by staff and opens from 8.40am for Y2-Y6 pupils.
