




## KS1 Newsletter

### Autumn Term 1



**Our topic this half term is 'Enchanted Woodland!'**  
**Below is some information about what your child will be learning in school.**

#### Numeracy

We will be focusing on number work. We will be counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be ordering numbers and learning the place value of numbers.

#### Art/D&T

We will hopefully be planning and making our own fairy doors and woodland scenes. We will also be making animal masks and doing some tree rubbings.

#### Well being

In school we will be talking lots about hand washing and general hygiene.

We will also be taking time to talk about our thoughts and feelings around settling back into school.

#### Reminders:

**PE-** Please ensure your child comes to school on their PE days wearing their PE kit- **black shorts/leggings, white polo shirt and black plimsols.**

#### PE days are:

**1ES-** Monday and Wednesday

**1HL-** Monday and Wednesday

**1NS-** Wednesday and Friday

**Reading, spellings and homework-** Please try to listen to your child read every night and return the Reading Logs daily so reading books can be changed.

Homework will be sent out every Friday and must be returned to school by the following Wednesday so it can be marked.

Spellings are given out every Friday ready for children to have a spelling test the following Friday. Spellings can be found in the back of your child's Reading Log.

#### English

During our English lessons, we will be reinforcing writing skills such as handwriting, capital letters, full stops and describing words.

We will also be reading and retelling some fairy tales such as Little Red Riding Hood and Hansel and Gretel.

#### Science

We will be learning about animals and plants that live in woodland areas. We will study different habitats of animals and learn about the different parts of plants and trees.

We are hoping to go on a local area walk in the next couple of weeks.
