#### **SCHOOL PROVISION**

We are providing **emergency care** for a **limited number of children in school**.

The school building is open for our more vulnerable pupils on roll and to support the children of our priority key workers. Our aim is to support as many families as we can and provision can be flexible based on need.

Though we are providing care for our children, the government advice states that:

**If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.  
Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be.**

The school offer for vulnerable pupils (priority) and children of key workers is zoned provision

**Our Home Learning will be our primary focus and this will also be the core of our learning delivered in school**

Zone 1: Nursery (N provision 8.30 – 11.30 **am only**) and Reception aged pupils (8.45am – 3pm) **commences Monday 18.01.20**

Zone 2: KS1 Years 1 and 2 (8.30am – 3.00pm)

Zone 3: KS2 Years 3 and 4 (8.40am – 3.00pm)

Zone 4: KS2 Year 5 (8.40am – 3.00pm)

Zone 4: KS2 Year 6 (8.40am – 3.10pm).

**Our catering service will provide a daily hot meal and all pupils are to attend in full uniform**

\* If you are a key worker and require support with childcare. Please contact the school office to check availability\*

#### **Devices: Tablets and laptops**

We have supplied over 40 devices to our families and still have a very limited number of laptops and tablets available for loan from school. There is priority access for vulnerable pupils and those families - known to have technology needs. A small number of devices are available for loan from the school office. #### **PACKED LUNCHES: Income related Free school meals**

We have tried to make contact with all eligible families and many of you have taken up the offer of a free packed lunch. Pre-ordered packed lunches are available daily from the Key Stage 2 dining hall doors between the hours of **11.00am and 12.30pm**.

If your child is eligible (FSM: Reception/ Y1-Y6 Free school meals) and you would like to order a packed lunch please contact the school office on 01642 816884

**The school office will be open daily hours: 8am – 3.30pm.**

From 18.01.21 the school will be providing **pre-ordered** packed lunches and grocery packs

From 25.01.21 – 12.02.21. We intend to move to the DFE 'Edenred' voucher scheme (3wks) – supporting our eligible families

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

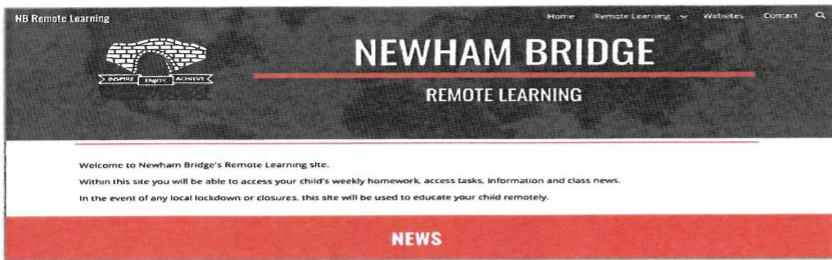
If your child or a member of your household display any symptoms of coronavirus

- **A high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- **A new, continuous cough** – coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- **A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – your child cannot smell/taste anything, or things smell /taste different

As Parents/ Carers you MUST to be ready and willing to:

- [book a test](#). Staff and pupils must not come into the school if they have symptoms, and must be sent home to self-isolate if they develop them in school. All children can be tested, including children under 5, but children aged 11 and under will need to be helped by their Parents/Carers if using a home testing kit
- provide details of anyone they have been in close contact with if they were to test positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) or if asked by NHS Test and Trace
- [self-isolate](#) if they have been in close contact with someone who develops coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms or someone who tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19)
- Anyone who displays symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) can and should get a test.
- Tests can be booked through the NHS [testing and tracing for coronavirus website](#), or ordered by telephone via NHS 119 for those without access to the internet. Essential workers, which includes anyone involved in education or childcare, have priority access to testing

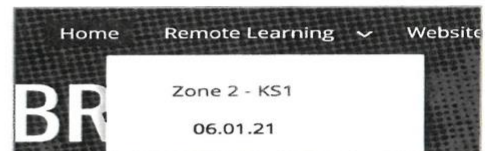


This is the home page and the first thing you will see.

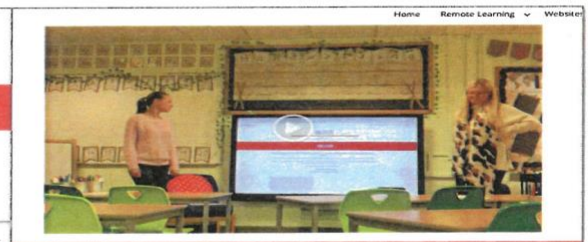


Go to the Remote Learning tab at the top of the page.
