Welcome to Year 3!

English

During our English lessons, Year 3 will be writing a range of genres, including writing a set of instructions for a British Afternoon Tea, writing a letter to the Queen and writing an adventure story of their journey across Middlesbrough.



Maths

During our Maths lessons this half term, we will be exploring the place value of numbers. We will be identifying how many hundreds, tens and ones make up a number, ordering and comparing numbers and counting in 50s. We will also consolidate our understanding of addition and subtraction.

Throughout our lessons, we will continue to practise our times tables.

Science

In Science, Year 3 will be learning about 'Forces and Magnets'. We will discuss what we already know, ask scientific questions and investigate with magnets.



PE

One session each week will be spent with Mrs Layton learning a variety of ball skills. In our 2nd session, we will develop these ball skills further by playing and learning the rules and tactics of rugby.

Our PE sessions are Monday and Wednesday.

Reading

In KS2, children take part in a reading scheme called Accelerated Reader. Children have received a letter and an information booklet this week to help with any questions you may have.
