# School Expectations

- School doors open at 8.40am
- Reading Plus/Accelerated Reader begins at 8.45am
- It is essential your child arrives at school on time. These are the latest figures:
  - Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
  - Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
  - Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.
- School finishes at 3.20pm, please make sure your child attends school every day. We really want your child to reach their full potential!

Reading is an integral part of each lesson.


Your child will access Reading plus/Accelerated Reader each morning, followed by a guided reading session which will focus on a range of skills.




