# Our School Day

- School doors open at 8.40am
- Focus activities start at 8.45am
- It is essential your child arrives at school on time. These are the latest figures:
  - Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
  - Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
  - Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.

# Our Behaviour Policy

  - Verbal Warning
  - Yellow Card
  - Red Card
  - Time out in another class
  - Isolations with the Deputy
  - Isolation with the Headteacher

# Phonics

- Phonics is the process in which children decode, segment and blend words to be able to read it
- Phonics is incredibly important to support your child's progress across the curriculum
- Phonics takes place every morning from 9:55am until 10:30am
- In Summer, the children in Year One will undertake a Phonics Screening Check

# Reading

- Read Write Inc. Book Bag Books
- The children will be given a phonetically matched book
- The children will need to read the same book two or three times to help build up their fluency and comprehension
- Reading Books, Reading Records and Book Bags must be in school every day
- Please try to read with you child every night
- When you read, please record what you have read with your child in their Reading Record.
- Please also write any comments or messages in your child's reading record. This ensures strong communication between school and home.



# Spelling

- Spellings will be sent out weekly in the back of your child's Reading Record
- They need to practice these spellings at home as often as possible
- Spelling Tests will be taken every Friday

# Maths

- **White Rose**

- In school, we use the White Rose Maths Programme
- Supports the children's ability to reason with numbers

- **Numbots**

- Numbots is an app that the children access to support their place value, addition and subtraction knowledge
- The children work through challenges to build their own robots
- The children will use this in school as well as at home
