School Expectations

- School doors open at 8.40am
- Morning learning begins from this time.
- It is essential your child arrives at school on time. These are the latest figures:
 - Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
 - Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
 - Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.



Reading


In Y6, your child will access Reading plus each day, along with guided reading session twice a week, which will focus on a range of skills.


We will also have time to read independently and quiz using accelerated reading and each class will share some fantastic class reads throughout the year.


Please encourage your child to continue reading at home at least 3 times each week.






Homework Club Every Tuesday till 4pm
