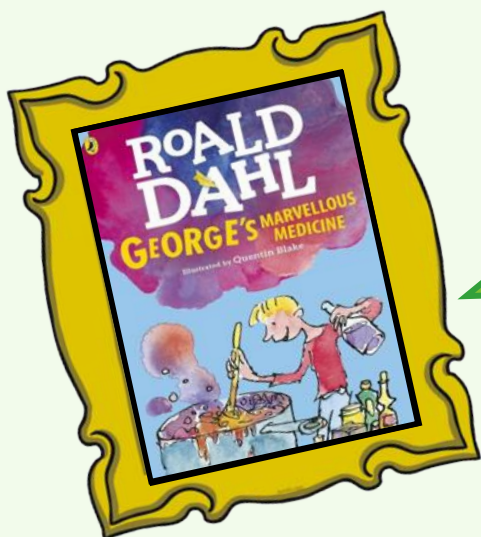


Did you know?
