Could it be your class next half term?

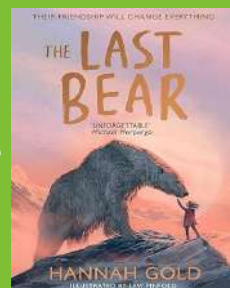
Staff Recommendation
